



Good Faith Effort Contract Renewal Waiver and Concurrence

If the State agency determines that the vendor made good faith efforts, the agency may issue a waiver after concurrence by the chief procurement officer. 30 ILCS 500/20-60(f).

Some of the subcontractors listed in the U-Plan did not perform work on the contract. For example, Valdes primarily operates as a parts supplier for service shops, providing products such as brake fluid, antifreeze, lubricants, oil, and chemicals. They do not offer any direct services beyond supplying these products.

InkaGroup, on the other hand, provides transportation services (semi-truck/trailer freight delivery) as well as truck and trailer repair services. These services include, but are not limited to, DPF systems, alignment, brakes, preventive maintenance (PM), body work, transmission, electrical, and clutch repairs.

The vendor submitted a capability statement for each BEP subcontractor, along with an explanation of their limited capacity to provide the specific services required under this contract. The vendor noted that this limitation is primarily due to the specialized nature of the work needed and the specific expertise of each supplier, which restricts the scope of work they can perform.

Despite these limitations, the vendor reached out to additional BEP-certified firms to perform the required work. These firms include:
