Subject: Small Purchase Maximums – FY 2020 CPI Adjustment

This notice is issued pursuant to Section 20-20(b) of the Illinois Procurement Code to show the Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment to the small purchase maximums for procurements of supplies, services, construction, and professional or artistic services. Agencies do not need to utilize a competitive method of source selection for contracts valued at or below these maximums.

The CPI for All Urban Consumers used to make the adjustment is a 1.8% increase in the all items index for the 12 months ending May 2019 and published June 12, 2019. The CPI is published by the United States Department of Labor Bureau of Labor Statistics.

The small purchase maximums for procurements under the authority of the Chief Procurement Officer for General Services are as follows:

- Supplies and Services: not exceeding \$101,800 (this is an increase from the FY19 amount calculated as \$100,000 X 1.8% rounded to the nearest \$100)
- Construction: not exceeding \$101,800 (this is an increase from the FY19 amount calculated as \$100,000 X 1.8% rounded to the nearest \$100)
- Professional or Artistic Services: not exceeding \$101,800 (this is an increase from the FY19 amount calculated as \$100,000 X 1.8% rounded to the nearest \$100)

This CPO Notice is effective July 1, 2019.
