

Subject: Small Purchase Maximums – FY 2022 CPI Adjustment

This CPO Notice is effective July 1, 2021.

I issue this pursuant to Section 20-20(b) of the Illinois Procurement Code (30 ILCS 500/) to show the Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment to the small purchase maximums for procurements of supplies, services, construction, and professional or artistic services. Agencies do not need to utilize a competitive method of source selection for contracts valued at or below these maximums.

The United States Department of Labor identified a 1.4% increase in the CPI for the 12-month period ending December 2019. This change is used to adjust the small purchase maximums.

The small purchase maximum for supplies and services, construction, and professional or artistic services procurements under the authority of the Chief Procurement Officer for General Services is **\$105,600** (this is an increase from the FY21 amount calculated as \$104,100 X 1.4% rounded to the nearest \$100).
