Subject: CPI for Small Purchases Fiscal year 2013

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This CPO Notice is effective July 1, 2012 and replaces CPO Notice 2012.01.

This is notice pursuant to Section 20-20(b) of the Illinois Procurement Code for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment to certain small purchase thresholds. These thresholds show the dollar value of contracts that may be procured by source selection determined to be most appropriate to circumstances, rather than the requirement for competitive procurement method published to public procurement bulletin.

The CPI percentage being used to make the adjustments is: 3.0%

Effective July 1, 2012, the small purchase thresholds for procurements under the authority of the CPO for General Services will be:

**Supplies and Services:** not exceeding \$35,000.00. (This is an increase from the FY 2012 amount calculated as \$34,000 + 3.0% rounded to the nearest \$100.00)

**Construction:** not exceeding \$ 42,000.00. (This is an increase from the FY 2012 amount calculated as \$40,700 + 3.0% rounded to the nearest \$100.00)

**Professional and Artistic Services:** less than \$20,000.00 (this amount is not subject to change. See 30 ILCS 500/35-35).
